

HEBRON COACH CODE OF CONDUCT

Coach's Responsibilities

- 1. Understand the rules of the game of baseball/softball/basketball. Read and understand the rules for play as established by GHSA and Hebron Sports Ministry.
- 2. Make every effort to keep abreast of events and meetings of the Hebron Sports Ministry and cooperate with the administrative requirements of managing or coaching a team in the league.

Standards of Behavior

- 1. Consistently demonstrate a positive role model to players and parents with a positive attitude, good sportsmanship, even temperament and professionally and constructively discuss any disputed rule violation with umpires/officials, (judgment calls are not debatable).
- 2. Under no circumstances is physical contact acceptable in a confrontational/disciplinary situation.
- 3. Unsportsmanlike conduct, obscene language or unruly behavior on the part of the coaches, fans, umpires or players will not be tolerated.
- 4. Alcoholic beverages of any form are not allowed at Hebron games or any Hebron function.
- 5. All tobacco products are not allowed inside the field/gym areas or at any Hebron function.
- 6. Although coaches cannot be responsible for the conduct of other adults, as a manager/coach, you should take the necessary actions to intervene and counsel parents/fans of players from your team whenever possible. Said parents/fans are subject to ejection from the park per the host park rules.

Violation of these standards will result in disciplinary action taken by Hebron Administration.

Coaches/players ejected from a game are automatically suspended from their next scheduled Hebron game. A 2^{nd} ejection may result in Hebron Administration taking further disciplinary action, up to and including expulsion from the league.

The person under said suspension must remove him/her self from the game in question.

As such, I do hereby agree to abide by the Mission Statement and philosophies of the Hebron Sports Ministry and the Rules as established by the Administration of Hebron Sports Ministry.

I also agree to support and adhere to the Hebron Sports Ministry Code of Conduct and Standards of Behavior expectations.
