DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR ROMANS 12: 3-8

The Gospel changes how we view ourselves and how we view other believers.

1. What, if anything, stood out to you in the text that was preached or in the sermon?
2. What in the text led you to ask more questions or to resolve to act in some way?
3. Why are we prone to think more highly of ourselves than we should?
4. Has there ever been a time in which you knew God was humbling you? If so, when was it?
5. When is the last time you were more prideful than humble and it led to a relational conflict with someone else? How do you think humility on your part would have made a difference?
6. What, if anything, do you do to combat pride on a daily basis? How could considering God and considering faith be helpful for producing humility in our lives?
7. Though the world tells us that we need to believe in ourselves more, how is this different from what the Bible says?
8. If we should ultimately put our faith in Christ rather than ourselves, what are some practical ways we can do this each day?
9. If self-help is not the ultimate answer we need, why do you think so many people stay in churches where this seems to be all that is taught?
10. How important is the Church to God and how do you know the answer to this question?
11. How important is the Church to you and how can others tell?
12. Why are those who do not see the importance of church either immature in their faith or disobedient?
13. It seems some people can easily walk away from faith family after faith family, but why should it not be “easy” to leave a body of believers to which we are united?
14. What are your spiritual gifts? How do you know these are your spiritual gifts?
15. Why do we sometimes wish God had given us different spiritual gifts?
