6. What are healthy steps we can take toward not being passive with our Kingdom responsibilities?

8. Have you ever served the Lord with your actions but not your attitude? If so, when was it? Do you think the Lord was pleased?
9. Why do you think the Lord desires for us to be fervent in Spirit?
10. What, if anything, has diminished your passion for Jesus in the past? What, if anything, is diminishing your passion for Jesus currently?
11. Paul admonishes us to "serve the Lord." Whom or what are you tempted to serve more than Jesus?
12. How can we be sure we are not just diligently and passionately serving the church, but instead we are diligently and passionately serving Christ?
13. Why is it important that what we do "for" Jesus we actually do "in" Jesus' power? How can we be sure we are relying on His power?
14. What, if anything, needs to happen in order for you and your family to diligently and passionately serve Jesus? What steps will you take toward this today?
