DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR 1 Cor. 15:29-34, 58

2. What, if any, questions do you still have about Christ's resurrection, our future resurrection, or what we should be doing between those two events?
3. What do you think "abounding" or "overflowing" in the work of the Lord looks like on a daily basis? What are some specifics?
4. Has there ever been a time when you were tempted to shift from the gospel to something else? How can we remain "Immovable" in the gospel and help others to do the same?
5. What are some things that will help us consistently or "steadfastly" work for the Lord?
6. In what way(s) does sin work against us working steadfastly in the Lord? How can we minimize being distracted by something that will ultimately be to our detriment?
7. How can we make sure that we are not just abounding in work or labor, but actually in the work of the Lord?
8. How do we work/labor in Christ's strength and not just ours?
9. How do we abound in the Lord's work but not boast about it or make it into a Pharisaical list of actions?
10. When was a time, if ever, you've been discouraged in your work for the Lord thinking, perhaps, that you were wasting your time or that whatever you were doing was not amounting to anything? How can 1 Cor. 15:58 give us confidence that our work is never wasted?
11. How has it been beneficial for you to spend the last three weeks considering the resurrection?
12. If you were able to attend or listen to any of the Passion Week Lunch teachings, how were they helpful so that Easter did not just "sneak up" on you?
