### **SERMON-BASED CURRICULUM**

#### **LOVING ACCOUNTABILITY**

As we partnered with God this past week to \_\_\_\_\_, what did He do? How did He work in and through us?

#### **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR 2 Samuel 11**

1. In what ways, if any, did God use 2 Samuel 11 to speak to you today? Were you challenged, convicted, encouraged, or reprovved in any way?
2. What questions do you have about 2 Samuel 11 or something you heard in the sermon?
3. Read 1 Pet. 2:11 and 1 Pet. 5:8. Why should we be vigilant against sin in our lives? In what ways are you “on guard” against your own propensity to sin?
4. In what ways are you striving to minimize your yielding to temptation and committing sin? What should we do in the initial moments we are tempted to sin?
5. Read Heb. 4:14-16. How often do you go to Jesus during your time of need to find the grace and mercy you need to resist temptation? How often should you?
6. Read Psalm 16:11. Why do we struggle to believe that there is more joy in obedience than in disobedience?
7. Read 2 Sam. 11:27, 2 Sam. 12:9-10, 14 again – How is sin described in these verses? Is this how you view sin? Why should it be?
8. Why do we often try to conceal sin rather than confessing it?
9. If someone you were discipling shared with you that he or she had been concealing sin, how would you counsel them? What steps should they take?
10. In what ways, if any, have you found that concealing sin has led to more sin in your life?
11. Why is it true that it may be “my sin” but it is always “our consequences”? What were some of the consequences of David’s sin with which others paid the price?
12. Is there any sin in your life now that is causing painful consequences for your family or this faith family? If so, what will you do about it?
13. In what ways are you helping others resist sin?
14. What should an accountability relationship look like with someone else? How should we pick an accountability partner?
15. What, if anything, do you believe the Spirit is calling you to believe or do in light of 2 Samuel 11?
