DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR GENESIS 1:26-31

1. What were the characteristics of Eunice and Lois that were passed on to Timothy? How does having godly parents positively impact a home? How might you make reproducing disciples within your own home regardless of your role (mom, dad, child)?
2. How was Paul's commission to Timothy in 2 Timothy 2:2 an example of generational disciple-making? What are the key characteristics Paul tells Timothy to look for when it comes to his investment?
3. In what ways are Jesus' final words in Matthew 28:18-20 shaping your life today? In what ways are they shaping the mission of Hebron? How are Jesus' final words and God's first words similar?
4. What does it mean in Genesis 1:26 that we are made "in the image of God"? How is that identity related to our worship?
5. What does it mean in Genesis 1:31 when God proclaimed all that He had made to be "very good?" How is that related to our obedience?
6. What does it mean in Genesis 1:28 when God "blessed them" and how is that different from material blessing?
7. How does the command to "be fruitful and multiply" apply to humanity today when the earth's population is so large? In what ways can we obey this command in addition to or apart from procreation (having physical children)? How might a single person obey this command? How might a married couple with children be disobedient to this command?
8. How might the command to "subdue" the earth abused in our day and age? How do we faithfully participate in subduing in a way that brings glory to God?
9. In what ways might does the fall of mankind necessitate the gospel? Disciple-making? How does the brokenness of the world hinder generational disciple-making?
10. Who is discipling you and how are they doing it? Who are you discipling (or who should you be discipling)?
