7. How can walking in God's truth together help protect us from false teachers?
8. Why do you think Jesus, Peter, Paul and John urged us to be so vigilant toward false teaching? How vigilant would you say you are against false teachers?
9. What are some ways listed in 2 John that we can use to recognize false teachers or false teaching?
10. Why do you think John does not want us to receive in our homes anyone who teaches false things about Christ?
11. What are ways that we sometimes "welcome" false teaching into our homes in subtle ways?
12. Why are passages like Eph. 4:11-16 and Col. 1:28-2:10 so important with regard to walking in God's truth and love together?
13. What are some ways, you and your connect group can help Hebron walk in truth and love?
