LOVING ACCOUNTABILITY

As we partnered with God this past week to _____, what did He do? How did He work in and through us?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR JUDE

1. In what way, did God use His Spirit and His Word in your life this morning?
2. What are the truths that God has called us, God loves us, and God is keeping us producing in your life? Any praise of God? Any passion for God?
3. If it's true that we've been called, loved, and are kept, why do we sometimes not "feel" loved by God? Why do we sometimes fear that He will not keep us? How can the Truth in Jude help us when we doubt God's love or His guarding us?
4. Why does it matter that God not only keeps and cleanses us but that He does both of those joyfully? In what ways is His joy evident in you and through you?
5. Why is important to be clear that we do not contend for the faith in order to be kept by God, but we contend for the faith because we are kept by God?
6. Why is it important to know for which faith we are to contend? According to Jude, which faith is it?
7. Why is it that in every generation there will be threats to the gospel not just outside the church but inside of it as well? Is there anything we can do to minimize the internal threats to the gospel?
8. How does Jude describe those who are working against the gospel? What should we do if any of what he sees in them can also be seen in us?
9. What does Jude say contending for the faith looks like? In what ways are you contending for the faith?
10. In what ways are you building up other believers in the faith? If you can't think of any, what should you do?
11. What should we do for those who are being pulled away from the faith, those who are walking away, and those who have walked away?
12. As we conclude our Haggai and the One Hit Wonders series, is there any way what we are learning is impacting how we are living? Is there something from this study that you will take with you as you walk with Christ?
13. Whom are you teaching/discipling in the Truth you are learning from these one chapter books in the Bible? Why is being able to study these books not only a grace but a stewardship?
14. Are there any verses in these books that you are using in your prayers to God? If so, which passages/verses are they?
15. Why should we pray God's Word back to Him? How often do you do this?
