DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR REVELATION 3:1-6

1. In what way(s) did God speak to you today through Rev. 3:1-6? In what ways, were you encouraged, reproved, strengthened, convicted, or empowered?
2. Why is it good that Christ knows the true story of each of His churches and is not fooled by any pretense? What impact should this truth have on us?
3. What gaps, if any, do you think there is between Hebron's reputation in Dacula/Gwinnett and our reality? What do you think people would say is true of us, but in reality it is not and what do you think people would say is not true of us, but in reality is?
4. What gaps, if any, do you think there is between your family's reputation and your reality?
5. Why are we so often tempted to pretend to be something other than we are with either other Christians or non-Christians? How and why should we avoid doing this?
6. Why do we at times incorrectly relate external ministry activity with internal spiritual vitality in a church? Why is "busiest" not always "best" for a faith family?
7. Knowing that "busiest" can lead to "burnout" in a church, how can a congregation maintain a focus on what Christ says matters most and not be driven by all the consumeristic preferences of those who think a church should have countless ministries? In seeking a church to join, why are so many tempted to look through the lens of their preferences rather than God's precepts about His Church?
8. What does spiritual vigilance look like in your life? What should it look like?
9. If Christ were to say "Wake Up" to your family or our faith family, what specific areas of concern do you think He would be addressing?
10. In what ways did God use you this week to help strengthen another believer? How often do you seek to strengthen the faith of others in your Connect Group?
11. How can we help each other minimize the stains of worldliness in our lives?
12. In what ways, should Jesus' promises to clothe us, keep us, and confess us to His Father fuel our obedience today?
