6. In what ways is it tempting for you to rely more on yourself than on Christ? How does it work out when you do?
7. How can we keep prosperity and affluence from working to the detriment of our daily dependence on Christ?
8. If true riches are found in Christ, why do we so often exhaust ourselves pursuing the riches of the world?
9. How often do you consider the truth that Christ covers our shame and what difference is this truth making in your life?
10. When was a time God reproved and disciplined you because He loves you, but you did not receive it as loving? Why are we tempted to reject the Lord's reproofs rather than receiving them and repenting?
11. Is there anyone you know who seems to be rejecting the Lord's reproofs? How can you come alongside them?
12. How can fellowship with Christ fuel faithfulness to Christ? What does this relationship look like in your life?
13. How can we help each other to remember that true prosperity and position are found only in Christ?
14. What letter to the churches in Asia has been most beneficial to you? What do you think the Spirit wanted you to hear?
