8. Who is someone you know who is currently rejecting Christ?

10. Why is saving faith more than just a “leap in the dark?”
11. Why is it significant that God not only provides atonement but adoption?
12. How often do you consider your adoption in Christ and all the privileges that come with it?
13. What should knowing we are born of God’s will (and not of blood, the flesh, or the will of man) produce in our lives?
