**WITNESSES TO THE LIGHT**

**John 1:6-13**

- I. **God graciously sends us to bear witness about Christ, so that all might believe in Christ. (1:6-8)**
  - a. God is a sending God.
  - b. God is a faithful God.
  - c. God is a gracious God.
  - d. God is a saving God.
  - e. As His witnesses,
    - i. We should remember we are not the Light.
    - ii. We should refrain from obstructing the Light.
    - iii. We should remain willing to suffer for the Light.
  
- II. **Without God's grace at work in our lives, we will not only fail to recognize Christ, but we will reject Christ. (1:9-11)**
  - a. His world failed to recognize Him.
  - b. His people refused to receive Him.
  
- III. **Those who respond to the gospel will not only receive life in the Light, but also the right to become children of God. (1:12-13)**
  - a. In His grace, God grants us regeneration through recognizing and receiving His Son.
  - b. According to His will, God grants us the right to not just be His creation but His children.
