- 8. What is the primary joy of Heaven (Rev. 21:3 and 22:4)? In what ways can we be guilty at times of elevating secondary blessings in Heaven to our primary focus?
- 9. Which of the characteristics in Revelation 21:8 is the most applicable warning for you, and how can you heed this warning today?
- 10. What does it mean that God and the Lamb are the temple in the new Jerusalem?
- 11. What do you think the garden imagery in this passage tells us about the mission of God in the whole Bible?
- 12. Why do you think John emphasizes "the nations" in Revelation 21-22?
- 13. What difference is the reality of Heaven and the reality of Hell making in your life currently?
- 14. What is one thing about your life that can be changed to be more "heavenly minded" to be more effective for "earthly good"?
