9. In your sowing of God's Word, have you been surprised where He's born fruit as well as surprised at where He hasn't? Was there someone you did not think would be receptive to the Word who was and someone who you thought would be receptive but they were not?
10. How is the parable of the mustard seed encouraging for those who work and pray for the expansion of the Kingdom of God?
