CHRIST OUR PASSOVER LAMB

Mark 14:12-26

Passage in a Sentence: Jesus gave us a meal to be shared so we will always remember the price He paid for our redemption and we will always rejoice in our reconciliation to God.

I. REMEMBER CHRIST'S PROVIDENCE IN ALL OF THE PREPARATIONS.

- a. Everything about Christ's incarnation, mission, substitution, death, and resurrection was appointed and not accidental.
- b. He was not in the wrong place at the wrong time, but in the right place at the right time.
- c. In Jerusalem, things were not falling apart but falling into place.
- d. Even the most corrupt cannot thwart His control.

II. REMEMBER CHRIST'S PROVISION FOR COVENANT PROMISES.

- a. Through the Passion of Christ, God keeps His covenant promises.
- b. That God's mercy may be poured on us, God's wrath was poured on Christ as His blood was poured out.
- c. In the new covenant, God makes four promises to His people (Jeremiah 31:31-34):
 - i. God promises to forgive us.
 - ii. God promises to put His Word in our hearts.
 - iii. God promises that each of us will know Him.
 - iv. God promises to always be our God and that we will always be His people.

III. REMEMBER CHRIST'S PICTURE FOR GOSPEL PROCLAMATION.

- a. Jesus is the fulfillment of the old picture of God's redemption.
 - i. Jesus is the lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world.
 - ii. Peter sees Jesus as our substitute. (1 Peter 1:18-19)
 - iii. Paul sees Jesus as our substitute. (1 Corinthians 5:7)
 - iv. The author of Hebrews sees Jesus as our substitute. (Hebrews 10:1-19)
 - v. How do you see Jesus?

- vi. The New Testament writers see Jesus' death as the fulfillment of the Passover: He suffered in the place of His people in order that they might be marked out by His blood and thus spared from God's wrath.
- b. Jesus gave us a new picture to remember our redemption. (1 Corinthians 11:17-34)
 - i. We participate in the Lord's Supper as a means of declaration.
 - 1. We declare what God has done in Christ.
 - 2. We declare what God has done in Christ for us.
 - 3. We declare that Christ is our Lord and our life.
 - ii. We participate in the Lord's Supper as means of consideration.
 - 1. We consider our relationship with the Lord.
 - 2. We consider our relationship with others.
 - iii. We participate in the Lord's Supper as a means of proclamation.
 - 1. We proclaim Christ is risen.
 - 2. We proclaim Christ reigns.
 - 3. We proclaim Christ will return.
 - iv. We participate in the Lord's Supper as a means of celebration.
 - 1. One day we will share in the marriage supper of the Lamb!
One day we will celebrate with the King of Kings in His Kingdom!
