REMEMBER

Ephesians 2:11-22

Passage in a Sentence: Remember that we who were once without hope and far from God have been brought near by the blood of Jesus and are being built together by the Spirit into a dwelling place for God.

- I. REMEMBER WHO WE WERE WITHOUT CHRIST. (2:11-12)**
 - a. At one time we were separated from Christ.
 - b. At one time we were alienated from the commonwealth of Israel.
 - c. At one time we were strangers to the covenants of promise.
 - d. At one time we were without hope.
 - e. At one time we were without God in the world.

- II. REMEMBER WHAT GOD HAS ACCOMPLISHED FOR US IN CHRIST. (2:13-18)**
 - a. But now Christ has brought us near by his blood.
 - b. But now Christ is our peace.
 - c. But now Christ has made peace.
 - i. Between Believing Jews and Believing Gentiles
 1. That He might create in Himself one new man
 - ii. Between God and His people
 1. That He might reconcile us to God in one body through the cross
 - d. But now Christ has preached peace.
 - e. But now Christ gives us access in one Spirit to the Father.

- III. REMEMBER WHAT WE ARE BECOMING IN CHRIST. (2:19-22)**
 - a. So, then we are no longer strangers and aliens.
 - b. So, then we are fellow citizens with the saints.
 - c. So, then we are members of the household of God.
 - i. Built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets
 - ii. Built on Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone
 - d. So, then we are joined together.
 - e. So, then we are growing into a holy temple in the Lord.
 - f. So, then we are being built together into a dwelling place for God.
