6. Why are our plans neither full-proof nor fool-proof? How can we strive to have more confidence in God than our plans?
7. What plans have you made that God clearly interrupted? Was there any clear evidence His plan was better?
8. Why do we have difficulty in accepting God's plans instead of our plans? Why should we trust God and His plans?
9. How can we maintain a heart that says, "Interrupt any of my plans at any time for Your purposes, Lord?"
10. What, if any, plans of God are you currently struggling to receive and rejoice?
11. How can we help each other trust the good (and sometimes painful) providence of God?
12. Why should the certainty of God's purposes prevailing be a comfort to us? How can this certainty fuel praise in our hearts and peace in our minds?
