- 10. In what ways are you challenged by Christ's example of hard work?
- 11. In what ways are you thankful for the work God did through Christ on the cross?
- 12. How can the gospel fuel our work?
- 13. In what ways is your work glorifying to God?
- 14. In what Kingdom work would you like to be more involved?
