SUFFERING SOJOURNERS WHO SING 1 PETER 1:3-5

Passage in a Sentence: No matter our circumstances as believers, worship is compelled as we set our eyes on God's triumph in Christ rather than our trials.

I. NO MATTER OUR PREDICAMENT OR PROBLEMS, GOD IS WORTHY OF ALL OF OUR PRAISE. (1:3)

II. OUR PRAISE IS FUELED BY HIS PROVISION. (1:3-5)

a. We praise God for His mercy. (1:3)

i. God's actions and affections toward us are according to His mercy and not our merit.

b. We praise God for causing us to be born again. (1:3)

- i. God causes us to have life that can never die.
- ii. Without regeneration, we cannot see or participate in the kingdom of heaven.

(John 3:3)

iii. God alone grants us eternal life through the resurrection of Christ and through His living and abiding Word.

c. We praise God for raising Jesus from the dead. (1:3)

d. We praise God for giving us a living hope. (1:3)

- i. Living hope means that we can be certain our problems will never overcome God's promises to us.
- ii. Nielson: Our living hope isn't some abstract feeling; our living hope is Jesus himself.
- e. We praise God for providing and protecting an inheritance for us. (1:4)
- f. We praise God for protecting us by His power and fueling our perseverance in the faith. (1:5)
