### LOVING ACCOUNTABILITY

### **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS 1 PETER 1:6-12**

1. In what way did God use His Spirit and His Word in your heart and mind as we studied 1 Pet. 1:6-12? What's one thing you think He's calling you to do this week in response to this text?
2. When are times that you can specifically remember rejoicing in God? When are times that you remember taking particular joy in your salvation?
3. What is the biblical perspective we should have about our trials? What do we allow at times to keep us from having this biblical perspective?
4. How can it be simultaneously true that we are grieved by a trial but also still be guarded by God? Why does His guarding not fully eliminate our griefs? Why is it important to understand that Christians will still experience trials and griefs?
5. What are some trials God has used in your journey in order to refine your faith?
6. Of the markers Peter provides for genuine faith (loving Christ, believing Christ, rejoicing in Christ with inexpressible joy), which is most evident in you and which is least evident?
7. Why is it important that the salvation Peter is discussing is the same salvation prophesied in the Old Testament?
8. Peter says this salvation was announced to his readers through the good news that was preached to them. Who shared the gospel with you when you received Christ?
9. Who is hearing the gospel from us? To whom are you announcing that the salvation into which angels long to look is here and available?
10. This passage is marked by rejoicing in the salvation God has provided in Christ. If this passage is a mirror for our lives, in what way is our rejoicing in God because of the gospel present and in what ways is it missing?
