3. What does Peter communicate about the relationship between the Gospel and God's Word? How do you think about the relationship between the Gospel and God's Word? What happens when we try to separate the Gospel from God's Word?
4. Why does Peter have to command the believers to love one another? Why do we still need the command to love one another today?
5. What are some practical ways that you have loved on our faith family or have been loved on by our faith family?
6. Peter quotes Isaiah 40 in verse 24. What is the context of Isaiah 40? Why is the context important for Peter's original audience?
7. How has God's Word been a comfort to you?
8. How does God use both the Gospel and our faith family to help us to look like Jesus? What are some ways that we fail to look like Jesus? What are some ways that we can hold one another accountable to look more like Jesus?
9. Do you long to grow in your relationship with Christ? In this passage, what are the two methods of growing with Christ prescribed by Peter? What are some ways that you are going to encourage one another to read God's Word this week? Who will you invite to your Connect Group this week?
