4. How much were you taught about biblical manhood and womanhood specifically in your church or home as you were growing up? If you did not learn about these things from your church or home, where did you learn them?
5. Why is willingly submitting to the authority of another so difficult for many of us?
6. What makes submission even more difficult when it's to someone who is not a believer?
7. Should a Christian marry a non-Christian? If so, then why, and if not, then why not?
8. In a typical week, would you say you give more focus on how you present yourself to the world or to God? Why should those who merely focus on what is external begin to focus on what is internal?
9. How do you think we can support or come alongside those who are living with difficult or unbelieving spouses?
10. When in a position of authority, why should we use that authority for the good of those we lead rather than just our own good? How can we do this?
11. Are we ever guilty of pretending our earthly relationships have no impact on our relationship with God? How does 1 Peter 3:7 correct this thought?
12. If you are a wife – how are you living out 1 Peter 3:1-6? If you are a husband – how are you living out 1 Peter 3:7?
