2. What are the similarities between adopting a child and being adopted as children of God? Why does Paul use the word picture of adoption to explain salvation?
3. Why do we struggle to rest in our identity and worth as adopted sons rather than try to earn our worth through works?
4. Do you find it difficult to trust God's perfect timing? Why or why not?
5. Why is it important that God sent His Son? How would your life change if you saw yourself sent from God to the people you interact with every day?
6. How is Jesus Christ like us? How is Jesus Christ different than us? Why are both these truths essential?
7. Why do we sometimes find it difficult to see ourselves as heirs with Christ? How do you change your perspective when you are tempted to not see yourself as an adopted child of God?
8. What are some of the benefits of being an heir with Christ mentioned in this passage? Are you taking full advantage of those benefits as a believer in Christ?
9. Galatians 4:6 reveals the gracious truth that we can bring anything to God? Is there anything that you are not giving over to God in your life? What is keeping you from having a close personal relationship with the Father mentioned in this verse?
10. What is one thing you believe you need to do or believe in the Spirit's power this week to live out something you've learned from Galatians 4:1-7?
