DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR JONAH 3

- 1. In what way(s) did God speak to you today through His Spirit and His Word?
- 2. When was a time God gave you a second opportunity to be obedient to Him with a specific command or burden despite your previous disobedience to Him? Why were you either obedient or disobedient (again) with this second (or third or fourth...) opportunity?
- 3. Why do you think God gave Jonah a second opportunity? Why didn't God just send someone else?
- 4. Why do you think God has given you multiple opportunities at obedience with some things? Why should we not presume we will have another opportunity at obedience later?
- 5. What is the Gospel message we are to share with others? Why is it important that we clearly understand and communicate the Gospel?
- 6. Jonah relayed the message God gave him. What do you find difficult about relaying the Gospel message to others?
- 7. The Ninevites received God's message and repented of their evil ways. When is a time you shared the Gospel with someone and they received it and repented of their sin?
- 8. When is a time you shared the Gospel and the person refused to receive the good news about Jesus? How did you respond?
- 9. Why is it important to always remember that we are responsible for relaying the gospel message to others, but we are not responsible for their responses?
- 10. God responded to the repentance of the Ninevites and did not destroy them, what should we learn from this and how should it comfort us?
- 11. What are ways you've seen God respond to your prayers (not just of repentance but any prayer)?
- 12. Is there any way you are refusing to relay the gospel to others?
- 13. Is there any aspect of God's Word you continue to reject by choosing not to receive it?
- 14. Is there any sin of which you are refusing to repent?
- 15. What truth is there in Jonah 3 that can fuel our rejoicing in God?
