- 3. For those you are discipling, what have you taught them about drawing near to God?
- 4. Why should we never lose wonder in the thought that God not only wants us to draw near to Him but has made a way for us to do so?
- 5. Why is Jesus our only means of drawing near to God? Why do we need a High Priest?
- 6. About what or whom do you think the author of Hebrews has in mind when he tells us that "a better hope is introduced?"
- 7. Why does the author compare Jesus and Melchizedek?
- 8. What encouragement/challenge can we take from Melchizedek living a righteous life in a very godless land?
- 9. How is Jesus able to save to the uttermost those who draw near to God? Why do we sometimes doubt this truth?
- 10. What comfort should we take from knowing that Jesus "always lives to make intercession for" us?
- 11. How can we not become desensitized to the glorious truth that for our sake Jesus "offered up himself?"
- 12. What are some key truths from this passage you want to be sure those you disciple understand? How will you disciple them in these truths?
