DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR MATTHEW 20:1-16

3. Why is entitlement such a big deal to Jesus? What does our entitlement say about how we view God and the Gospel?
4. What would change this week if we asked: "What has God given me?" instead of "What does God owe me?"
5. What are some things that you have complained about in the past month? Do you think those things were worth the complaint? Why or why not?
6. What are things that we are tempted to covet?
7. How would our attitude towards other Christians change if we saw their success as building the kingdom instead of our competition?
8. How do thankfulness and rejoicing keep us from complaining and coveting?
9. How can we help one another stop complaining and coveting this week? Consider memorizing Philippians 2:14 this week.
10. What is one thing you believe you need to do or believe in the Spirit's power this week to live out something you've learned from Matthew 20:1-16?
