3. Why are questions about eternal life the most important questions in the world?
4. What questions have you had about obtaining or receiving eternal life in your past or present?
5. With whom are you currently engaging in conversations about eternal life?
6. Jesus is convinced the answers to the questions that matter most can be found in the Word. Why should we have the same confidence in the Word we've received from the Lord?
7. When was a time that you knew the right biblical answers but lacked the right biblical actions?
8. Why is it important that what we do "with/for" Christ flows out of first being "in" Christ?
9. Even if we cannot fully achieve loving God with everything we have and loving our neighbor as ourselves, why should we still make these our daily aim?
10. What are ways you may have tried to lower God's standard to a righteousness you could earn or achieve? Or when was a time you wanted to do just the minimum "necessary" to be in good standing with the Lord?
11. Jesus utilized the Samaritan because he knew how his audience viewed Samaritans. Whom would Jesus include in the parable if he was wanting to get your attention?
12. What are ways you've benefited from the kindness or mercy of others who took time to get involved in your mess?
13. If when we see the needs of others we are more often tempted to self-protection rather than serving, what should we do?
14. How are you currently reflecting both the life and the love you've received from Christ? How do you want, by God's grace, hope to reflect His life and love more clearly?
