3. On this side of the cross, why do we sometimes take for granted the access to God provided for us by the blood of Christ?
4. What do you need to do to be more intentional about fellowshiping with God and taking advantage of the access Christ has provided?
5. Why couldn't all of the regulations and rituals performed by the priests ultimately cleanse God's people?
6. What are ways we try to settle for just an "external" righteousness rather than an internal cleansing of our heart?
7. In what ways can a guilty conscience keep us from delighting in God and serving Him?
8. In what ways have you struggled at times to really believe that Christ can fully cleanse you from all your intentional and unintentional sins?
9. Why is Jesus' blood superior and sufficient for our atonement?
10. Why should our cleansing lead also to our communion with God and commissioning for God?
11. Why is it important to understand that we are not cleansed by serving God but cleansed to serve God?
12. Have you truly been cleansed by Christ? How do you know?
13. In what ways has your being cleansed by Christ led to serving the living God? How will you strive to serve Him this week?
