STEWARDING GOD'S GIFTS

Matthew 25:14-30

Passage in a Sentence: As we wait for Christ's return, we should steward our resources for the good of His Kingdom.

I. WE ALL HAVE GIFTS.

- a. All our gifts are given because of God's decision.
- b. All our gifts are given at God's discretion.

II. WE SHOULD LEVERAGE OUR GIFTS TO FURTHER GOD'S KINGDOM.

- a. Faithfulness is the celebrated attribute.
- b. Faithfulness with little leads to increased opportunity and responsibility to steward more.

III. WE DISPLAY OUR UNDERSTANDING OF THE KING AND THE KINGDOM THROUGH USING OUR GIFTS.

- a. Those who don't steward their gifts for God's Kingdom misunderstand the Kingdom.
- b. Those who don't steward their gifts for God's Kingdom might not know the King.
