4. What should I do if I'm a believer but currently in a pattern and pursuit of specific sin or sins?
5. Why is deliberate sin a trampling of the gospel and the work of Christ?
6. How can we know from this passage that deliberate sin is grieving to all members of the Trinity?
7. Why should those who trample the gospel expect and deserve a worse punishment than those who broke the Old Testament law?
8. Why is it a fearful and dreadful thing to fall into the hands of the living God and for whom are you concerned of this happening in your friendships and relationships?
9. What are some ways you may be trying to avoid suffering for sake of the gospel?
10. Who do you know that may be suffering because of the gospel and what are you doing to serve and strengthen them?
11. For the sake of the gospel, how can we have a joyful and sacrificial attitude toward losing all of our earthly goods if needed? What keeps you from having a heavenly perspective toward your earthly material items?
12. Why do we need a faith that endures?
13. Who is helping you endure in your faith? Whom are you helping endure in their faith?
14. Why is it not only acceptable but important to consider Kingdom rewards?
15. When was a time you were tempted to shrink back from the gospel? When was a time you refused to shrink back from the gospel?
