3. The writer of Hebrews 11:23-34 gives examples of how faith plays out in the lives of the people mentioned? How does your faith change you? How does it affect you daily?
4. According to Hebrews 11, faith was both for thriving and suffering. Do you think that is still true? Why or why not?
5. Why do you think faith that leads to thriving is often elevated over faith that helps the sufferer?
6. What is the connection between faith and perseverance? Where do we see the connection in the text? How can you practically use this text to encourage the perseverance of others?
7. What are weights that hold people back from fully following Jesus? How do we “lay aside every weight”?
8. Why does the writer of Hebrews say that sin “clings so closely”? What does that mean? How have you seen this in your life or the lives of others?
9. What are some practical ways that we can help others look to Jesus?
10. What are reasons we grow weary or become fainthearted? How does faith in Christ help us in those situations?
11. What is one thing you believe you need to do or believe in the Spirit’s power this week to live out something you’ve learned from Hebrews 11:23-12:3?
