6. How can we have a true heart in full assurance of faith when we draw near to God?
7. Why should we hold fast to the gospel without wavering? What tempts us to not hold fast to God’s promises?
8. How are you helping others in our faith family hold fast to the gospel and to God? How are you encouraging them in the promises of God? Who from Hebron is encouraging you in the Word?
9. How much thought and intentionality are you giving to how you can stir others in our faith family to love and good works?
10. What do you allow to keep you from gathering in corporate worship or with your Connect Group? Why should we not neglect to meet together?
11. Who at Hebron has encouraged you and helped you grow in the gospel? Who at Hebron are you encouraging and helping to grow in the gospel?
12. What needs to be done in your schedule and life so that you have more time to meet with other believers and live out Hebrews 10:19-25? Why do we need to do this more and more?
