DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR HEBREWS 12:18-29

1. In what way did God use His Spirit and His Word in your heart and mind as we studied Hebrews 12:18-29?
2. Why does the author point out differences between “Mt. Sinai” and “Mt. Zion”? What is the author of Hebrews encouraging us to do in light of these differences?
3. If the description of “Mt. Zion” is true—that God’s kingdom will be filled with joy, fulfillment, and satisfaction—does that truth make a difference in your life today? Why or why not?
4. Why is it important to understand that God does not change, but our ability to approach Him changed because of Christ? How do you take advantage of this opportunity to approach Him?
5. What would you say to someone that believes that the God of the Old Testament and the God of the New Testament are different? What does Hebrews 12 teach us about God? How does Hebrews 12 equip us to correct people who believe that God has changed?
6. What are ways that we refuse to listen to God’s voice? How can we encourage one another to listen and obey God this week?
7. What is the difference between terror and awe? Which one describes your approach to God?
8. Where do you turn when things are “shaken” in your life? Does it give you comfort that God’s kingdom is unshakeable? Why or why not?
9. Are you investing your time, talents, and treasures towards God’s eternal, unshakeable kingdom? Can you share an example? How can we encourage one another to invest in things that will last?
10. What does the author mean by “acceptable worship”? How can you encourage your family and friends to worship God in an acceptable manner?
11. Does your life reflect gratitude? Why or why not? What are some practical ways we can encourage one another to be grateful?
12. What is one thing you believe you need to do or believe in the Spirit’s power this week to live out something you’ve learned from Hebrews 12:18-29?
