4. How do you understand the term "firstborn" in verses 15 and 18?

7. If Christ is the image of God, then what are some applications for the Church as the body of Christ?
8. Read Colossians 1:13-14. How does the truth about Christ in verses 15-17 make the truth about us in verses 13-14 even more incredible?
9. Verse 16 says that all things were created for Christ. What does that say about the rightful place of Christ in our lives?
10. What is a major take-away that you will carry with you today?
