- 7. If Christ is the image of God, then what are some applications for the Church as the body of Christ?
- 8. Read Colossians 1:13-14. How does the truth about Christ in verses 15-17 make the truth about us in verses 13-14 even more incredible?
- 9. Verse 16 says that all things were created for Christ. What does that say about the rightful place of Christ in our lives?
- 10. What is a major take-away that you will carry with you today?
