DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR EXODUS 17:8-18:27

1. In what way(s), did God speak to you today through His Spirit and His Word?
2. What enemies are easier to fight, those outside of us (See Ephesians 6:10-20) or those inside of us (See James 4:1-10)? How do we ultimately rely on the Lord to fight those battles?
3. The passage states the Israelites were still supposed to fight, though they were trusting the ultimate victory to the Lord. How is this battle similar to the Christian life?
4. Moses built an alter and called it "The LORD is My Banner." Share some verses that have become reminders of God's faithfulness in your life. If you do not have a verse, encourage your group to memorize a verse together that will help recount God's blessings and faithfulness.
5. When was the last time you shared with someone what the Lord has done for you? What are ways that you recall God's goodness towards you?
6. Is there anyone in your life who needs to hear the Gospel from you? Share names of people who need the Gospel and pray that your group will be faithful to share.
7. What are ways you are helping your faith family grow in Christlikeness?
8. Why is it important to recognize and implement God's design for the faith community?
9. Does it bring you comfort or despair knowing the burden of shepherding God's people needs to be shared? How does shepherding practically play out in the life of our church?
10. What is the danger of placing all the shepherding burden on one person?
