3. When we do sin and we feel shame, how can we train ourselves to run to God rather than running from Him and hiding? How can we be convinced He wants us to run to Him?
4. What hope should we feel knowing that we've been released from the judgments against us because of Christ's substitution in our place? What difference should this make in how we live each day?
5. What are you looking forward to most about the day when God completely sets you free not just from sin but from sinning?
6. How can knowing a day is coming when God will fully and finally put away our enemies of the flesh, the devil, and the world help us in the daily battles we face now?
7. Why is God's presence with us the greatest prize of the Gospel and of Heaven? How much delight do you take in His presence with us now?
8. When was a time God stilled the chaos or concern in your heart and brought comfort?
9. What joy do you take in knowing the God rejoices and sings over His children?
10. Why do you think some Christians struggle to believe Zephaniah 3 and that God would/could/is singing over them?
11. Because our Father will rejoice over people from every nation, what's one thing you can do this week to see the Gospel advance to our neighbors and the nations?
12. In light of the truths in Zephaniah 3:14-20, how will you rejoice this week in our Father who rejoices over us?
