FREE AND FAITHFUL

Exodus 20:22-23:19

Passage in a Sentence: By the power of the Spirit, we are to use our freedom to live for the good of others and the glory of God.

I. CONSIDER THE FAITHFUL WORDS TO THOSE WHO ARE FREE.

- a. The Law was not given for redemption but for the redeemed.
- b. The Law was given so the redeemed would know how to live rightly.
- c. The Law was meant to be representative but not exhaustive.
- d. For us, the principles of the Law are still relevant while not all the practices of the Law are still required.

II. CONSIDER THE FAITHFUL WORK OF THOSE WHO ARE FREE.

- a. Regulations that protect the most vulnerable still matter.
- b. Responsibility and restitution still matter.
- c. Having regard for the good of others still matters.
- d. Remembering and resting in God's work still matters.

III. CONSIDER THE FAITHFUL WORSHIP BY THOSE WHO ARE FREE.

- a. Worship should always be a priority.
- b. Worship should always be pure.
- c. We worship the only God who is present.
- d. We worship the only God who has provided.

 - ii. He gave His Son who purified us from our sin.
