6. What can we learn from the contents of the Ark of the Covenant in Exodus 25:16? What does this teach us about how we should worship God?
7. The presence of God is a big deal to the Israelites. How much emphasis do you put on the presence of God?
8. The Israelites were given specific regulations to access God. Do you think we take our open access to God, through Christ's sacrifice, for granted? Why or why not?
9. How does Hebrews 9 help us better understand the Tabernacle? Does Hebrews 9 change the way you read Exodus 25-27, 35-40?
