- 7. The presence of God is a big deal to the Israelites. How much emphasis do you put on the presence of God?
- 8. The Israelites were given specific regulations to access God. Do you think we take our open access to God, through Christ's sacrifice, for granted? Why or why not?
- 9. How does Hebrews 9 help us better understand the Tabernacle? Does Hebrews 9 change the way you read Exodus 25-27, 35-40?
