DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR EXODUS 28-30 AND 39

1. In what way(s) did God speak to you today through His Spirit and His Word?
2. What comfort do you think it would've brought God's people for a lamp to be lit all through the night in the tabernacle as a symbol of God's life-giving, light-spreading power? In what ways do you take comfort in His presence with us and how often are you offering Him praise?
3. Why is it important that Aaron and his sons were called to the priesthood and did not appoint themselves? Why should there be no self-appointed pastors, elders, or deacons in a church?
4. The garment the high priest was to wear was to be holy, glorious, and beautiful, what does this teach us about God (Use Psalm 96:6 and Psalm 29:2 to help you)?
5. Read Isaiah 61:10. Why are these garments more important than just wearing our "Sunday best"?
6. Why is it significant that the High Priest would carry the names of the 12 tribes of Israel into the presence of God as He ministered? How does Christ do this for us?
7. In what ways is Jesus a superior High Priest to all who preceded Him and why will we never need another High Priest besides Jesus?
8. In what way do you experience Christ's ministry as our High Priest on a weekly basis?
9. How do we know that all Christians are called to minister as Kingdom priests today?
10. What does your ministry as a Kingdom priest look like on a weekly basis? What prayers and praise are you offering? What ministry to others are you demonstrating?
11. What does communion/fellowship with God look like in your life on a daily basis?
