- 5. In what ways are you challenged by Paul's willingness to suffer for the sake of the Gospel?
- 6. Why would we ever be tempted to change the message of the Gospel? Why does the Gospel not need to be changed?
- 7. How are you stewarding the Gospel message that's been entrusted to you? Who is hearing the Gospel from you? Whom are you helping grow in the Gospel? Where are you going with the Gospel?
- 8. In what ways are you challenged by the service and faithfulness of Onesiphorus? Whom are you supporting and refreshing in the Gospel?
- 9. How are you striving to be intentional and consistent in standing with and supporting others in the Gospel? What does this look like in your Connect Group, your friend group, and all the other groups in which you find yourself?
- 10. Onesiphorus had a reputation of frequent and faithful service in the church at Ephesus? What do you hope people in our faith family will remember about your service to the Lord?
