6. Why do differences often lead to friction between believers? How do we teach others the importance of pursuing unity despite differences?
7. What comes to mind when you think of deacons? Why?
8. What were the qualifications of the men chosen in Acts 6? What can the church learn about deacons from this passage? What does this tell us about the importance of character in church leaders?
9. What are the connections between the physical needs and the spiritual needs in the early church seen in Acts 6? How did God equip the church to meet both physical and spiritual needs?
10. What are ways that you have pursued unity within our faith family? How has God used you or someone you know to preserve unity within our faith family?
