- 3. What are some excuses you have used for not sharing the Gospel in the past? How can we use Acts 4 to help overcome those excuses?
- 4. What does persecution look like today? Why do we fear persecution? How can we encourage those who are persecuted?
- 5. When should believers disobey those in authority? How do we teach those whom we disciple when to obey and when to disobey?
- 6. How do we know when awe of God and the Gospel is driving our praise and not just our feelings or preferences?
- 7. What are some reasons to praise God today?
- 8. What are some truths we learn about God from the church's prayer in Acts 4:24-30?
- 9. How do you respond knowing God is sovereign over all things?
- 10. How often do you pray God-centered prayers instead of me-centered prayers? What are ways to ensure that our prayers are God-centered?
- 11. How often does Scripture show up in your prayers? Why is praying Scripture important?
- 12. What does being bold with the Gospel look like today?
