- 3. When was the last time God called you to step out and do something to benefit the kingdom? Why are we hesitant to step out in faith?
- 4. What is the importance of being able to see Christ in all the Scriptures, even passages in the Old Testament? What do we learn from Phillip sharing the Gospel to the Ethiopian?
- 5. Why is the Ethiopian eunuch such an unlikely convert?
- 6. What are ways that you are obeying Christ in your life? Are there opportunities where you have not yet been obedient to Christ? Why?
- 7. Share a time when God used your obedience to lead someone to Christ or to encourage someone in their faith?
- 8. What can we learn about baptism from this passage of Scripture?
- 9. How does your Christian life reflect joy? What are ways that you rejoice because of your salvation?
- 10. What are the connections you see between this passage and Luke 24? How do we see the pursuing nature of our God?
