- 2. Which part of Paul's conversion stands out the most to you? Which part is most surprising?
- 3. What are some other details we can add about Paul's conversion from other places in Scripture where he talked about it (Acts 22, Acts 26, Galatians 1-2, Philippians 3)?
- 4. What are some similarities and differences between Saul's conversion and the Ethiopian Eunuch's conversion that we looked at last week in Acts 8?
- 5. What is the significance of Jesus claiming that Saul's persecution of the church is persecution of Jesus?
- 6. If you were in Ananias's shoes (sandals?), how would you have responded to the Lord's vision in verses 10-16?
- 7. What was the possible spiritual significance of Saul's loss and recovery of sight?
- 8. What is the significance of Ananias referring to Saul as "Brother Saul?"
- 9. How does Saul increase in strength in v. 22?
- 10. Why do you think the Jewish leaders were so adamant to kill Saul after he began talking about Jesus to them? What is it about Jesus that drew such emotions out of people?
- 11. In our study of this passage, what aspect of it gives you the most hope?
