FAITHFULNESS THROUGH HARDSHIPS

ACTS 13:13-52

Passage in a sentence: We should be faithful witnesses to proclaim the Gospel, even when life is difficult and there is opposition, knowing that God gives us joy and Himself.

- I. BE FAITHFUL TO GOD WHEN LIFE IS DIFFICULT. (13:13-14a)**
 - a. Be faithful to God regardless of the location.
 - b. Be faithful to God regardless of the leadership.
 - c. Be faithful to God regardless of who leaves you.

- II. BE FAITHFUL TO GOD BY PROCLAIMING THE GOSPEL. (13:14b-43)**
 - a. We receive the benefit of God's faithfulness.
 - b. We receive the benefit of forgiveness.
 - c. We receive the benefit of freedom.
 - d. We receive the benefit of following godly leaders.
 - e. We receive the benefit of God's grace.
 - f. We receive the benefit of God's Word.

- III. BE FAITHFUL TO GOD WHEN OPPOSITION ARISES. (13:44-48, 50-51)**
 - a. Opposition to God starts with jealousy.
 - b. Opposition to God always goes against God's Word.
 - c. Opposition to God will be overcome.

- IV. BE FAITHFUL TO GOD WHO GIVES US JOY AND HIMSELF. (13:48-49,52)**
 - a. There is joy in our salvation.
 - b. There is joy when God's Word is spread.
