3. How are you challenged by Barnabas and Paul both being willing to come to Antioch and serve and now being willing to go wherever the Lord would send them? How can we maintain such an openness to the Lord's plans for our lives as well?
4. When we worship the Lord what role can fasting play in that process? Why do you think fasting is mentioned twice in this passage?
5. How can fasting be utilized correctly and what are temptations that cause fasting to become corrupted?
6. In the church at Antioch, there was evidence of the Spirit's leading through gifts (teachers/prophets) but also emphasis on His leading through going (set apart/sent out) – how do you see the Spirit's leading in both of these ways (gifts/going) at Hebron?
7. When Paul and Barnabas arrived at Salamis, why do you think they first proclaimed the word of God in the synagogues instead of the streets?
8. With whom did you have an opportunity to share the Gospel this week? How were you faithful or unfaithful with that opportunity?
9. As you've tried to minister to others, when have you experienced opposition to the Gospel?
10. How did you see the Gospel advance in you and through you in 2023? How do you hope to see the Gospel advance in you and through you in 2024?
