**ACTS 16:11-40**

1. In what way(s) did God speak to you today through His Spirit and His Word?
2. Why is it important that Paul and Silas were not just called to go to Macedonia but to preach the gospel to the Macedonians? What can we learn from this calling?
3. Like Paul and Silas in traveling to Macedonia, how were you immediately obedient to the Lord's leadership this week?
4. Why is it significant the first church planted in Macedonia was in a leading Roman city? What does this tell us about God's plan for advancing His gospel?
5. Like Lydia, how did the Lord open your heart to pay attention to the gospel? Why do we need the Lord to open our hearts?
6. How is hope fueled in our hearts when we see God's power of demonic holds in this text?
7. What can we learn from the persecution Paul and Silas experienced as they followed God's call to preach the gospel in Philippi?
8. After being beaten and thrown into the inner prison and having their feet fastened in the stocks, how are you challenged by Paul and Silas praising the Lord at midnight?
9. Like the jailer in our text, when is the last time you rejoiced in God bringing you to faith in Christ? How can we do this daily?
10. Why are Gospel partnerships important? How can your Connect Group encourage some of Hebron's gospel partners this week?
