



HOW ARE WE SAVED?

Acts 15:1-35

Passage in a Sentence: As those who are saved by grace alone through faith alone in Christ alone, we are called to defend the gospel passionately, to define the gospel clearly, to declare the gospel joyfully, and to disciple in the gospel continuously.

- I. **AS THOSE SAVED BY GRACE ALONE THROUGH FAITH ALONE IN CHRIST ALONE, WE ARE CALLED TO DEFEND THE GOSPEL PASSIONATELY.**
 - a. When others attempt to change or contradict the gospel, we should be concerned.
 - b. When others attempt to change or contradict the gospel, we should be willing to confront them.

- II. **AS THOSE SAVED BY GRACE ALONE THROUGH FAITH ALONE IN CHRIST ALONE, WE ARE CALLED TO DEFINE THE GOSPEL CLEARLY.**
 - a. We all need Gospel clarity.
 - i. Salvation is by grace alone.
 - ii. Salvation is through faith alone.
 - iii. Salvation is in Christ alone.

 - b. We all need Gospel convictions.
 - i. God has confirmed the gospel with His Spirit.
 - ii. God has confirmed the gospel with His signs.
 - iii. God has confirmed the gospel with His Scriptures.

III. AS THOSE SAVED BY GRACE ALONE THROUGH FAITH ALONE IN CHRIST ALONE, WE ARE CALLED TO DECLARE THE GOSPEL JOYFULLY.

- a. We need to communicate the gospel faithfully.
- b. We need to celebrate the gospel fervently.

IV. AS THOSE SAVED BY GRACE ALONE THROUGH FAITH ALONE IN CHRIST ALONE, WE ARE CALLED TO DISCIPLE IN THE GOSPEL CONTINUOUSLY

- a. We are to help other believers grow in the gospel.
- b. We are to help other believers go with the gospel.
